

## Autodesk Announces 2012 Enhancements to Subscription Program February 6, 2012

Along with upgrades to the latest software releases, online technical support, and flexible licensing privileges, Autodesk Subscription now provides 25 GB of Autodesk Cloud storage per seat. This year Autodesk has expanded its Subscription offering to provide a broader range of cloud computing capabilities to Subscription customers. In addition, some adjustments to Subscription pricing will be made. A summary of the changes you can expect as an Autodesk Subscription customer follows.

### Broader Range of Cloud Computing Capabilities

In 2012 Autodesk will expand cloud computing capabilities for Subscription customers in three ways:

#### I. More Cloud Storage

Cloud storage space will increase from 3 GB to 25 GB per user on Subscription. This will allow customers to store more design documents in the cloud—giving you anytime, anywhere access to your work, simplifying collaboration across teams, and more.

#### II. Cloud Services More Widely Available

Previously, only certain cloud services were available with a Subscription to select products or suites. In 2012 customers with a Subscription to any Autodesk commercial product or suite (with the exception of AutoCAD LT) will have access to the following range of cloud-based services offered through Subscription:

- Document storage and sharing
- Web & mobile viewing, editing and mark-up
- Rendering\*\*
- Energy Analysis\*\*
- Design Optimization\*\*
- Simulation\*\*
- And more to come!

*\*\*Some cloud services are only compatible with certain products.*

#### III. Varying Capacity Levels

The number of cloud units (or compute capacity) available for compute-intensive services, such as rendering, energy analysis, optimization or simulation, will vary depending on the customer's Subscription as follows:

- A Subscription to a single point product = 100 cloud units
- A Subscription to a standard suite = 100 cloud units
- A Subscription to a premium suite = 250 cloud units
- A Subscription to an ultimate suite = 500 cloud units

Later this year, Autodesk will also begin to offer the option to purchase more cloud units—on top of what is included with Subscription.

### Changes to Subscription Pricing

Autodesk hasn't made any significant changes to Subscription pricing for the last six years. As Autodesk continues to enhance the value of Subscription, some pricing changes will be made, as follows:

- Effective March 27, 2012, Subscription pricing, for the majority of Autodesk products, will be adjusted. For most products, this will result in a modest increase to Subscription pricing. For some products, Subscription pricing will slightly decrease.
- Subscription pricing increases will apply to the sale of new seats only.
- The cost of renewing an existing seat on Subscription will not increase until February 2013.
